Jacob (Jakub) Byczek and Catherine (Katarzyna) Dybas were married on 7/18/1842 at the Catholic church located in Osobnica. Both were born in Osobnica. Jacob was 33 years old and Catherine was 20 years old. The parents of Jacob Byczek were Joachim Byczek and Lucy (Łucja) Kwilosz from House #118 Osobnica. Catherine's parents were Sebastian Dybas and Catherine (Katarzyna) Nowak from House #181 Osobnica.

Jacob Byczek and Catherine Dybas had a total of nine known children, all born at House #118:

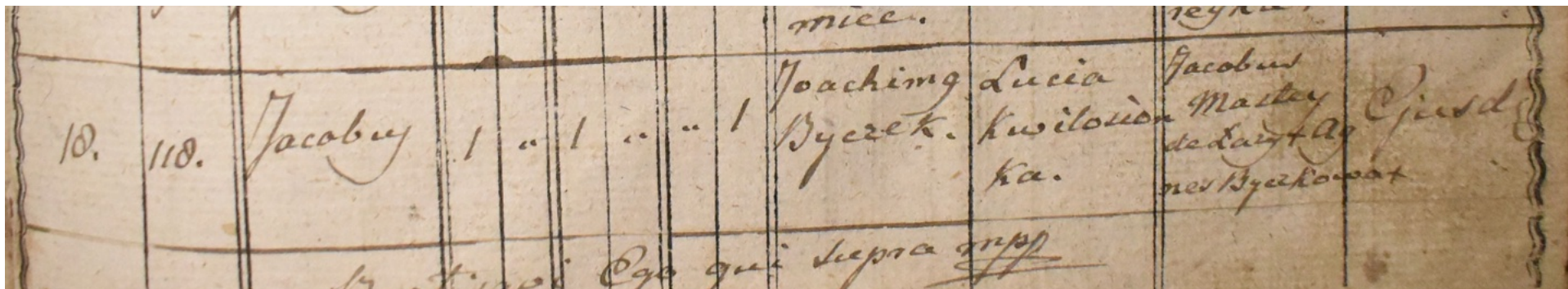

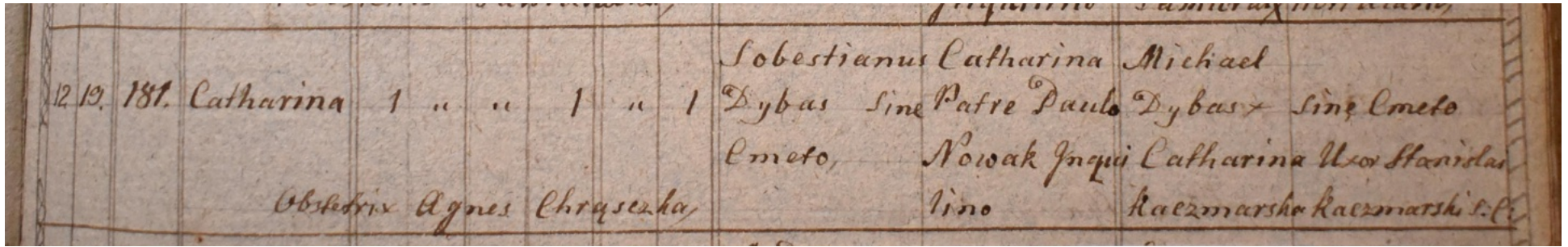
Jacob Byczek was a widower when he married Catherine Dybas in 1842. His first wife was Catherine (Katarzyna) Stygar, daughter of John (Jan) Stygar and Sophia (Zofia) Smolenionska. They were married on 2/21/1830 in Osobnica. Catherine was born in 1811 at House #121 and passed away on 4/12/1841 at House #118. Jacob Byczek and Catherine Stygar had a total of four known children, all born at House #118.

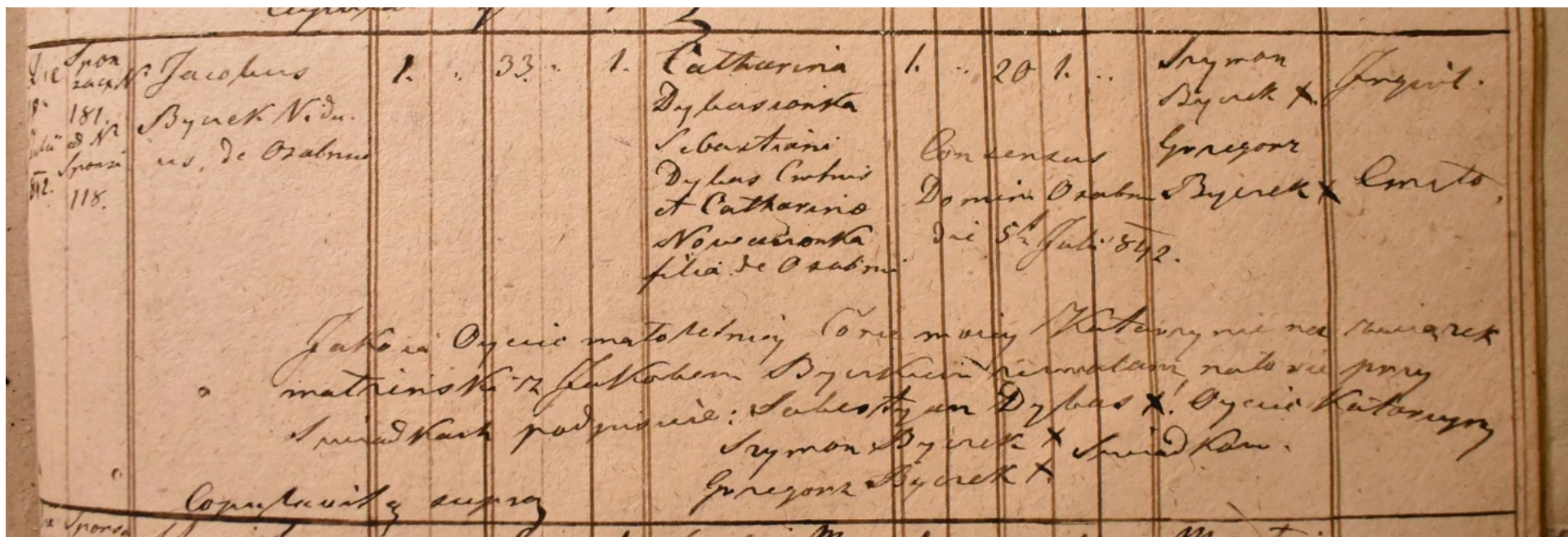

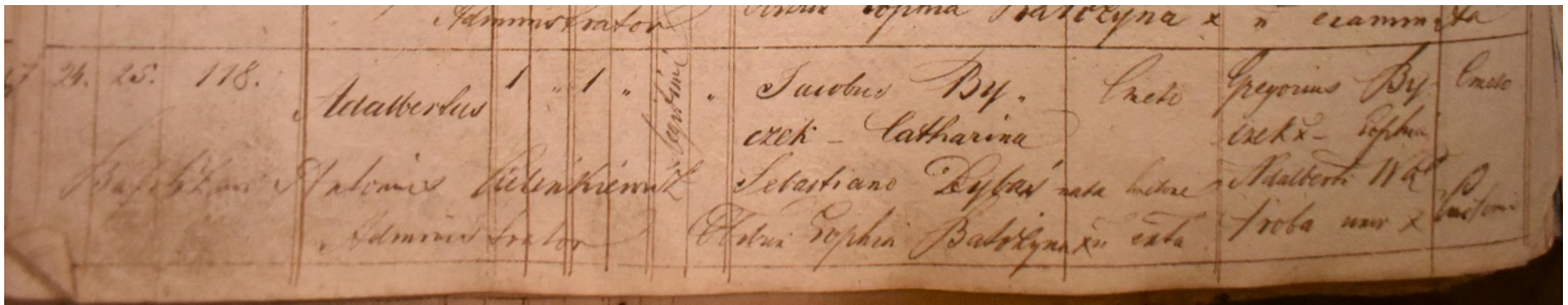

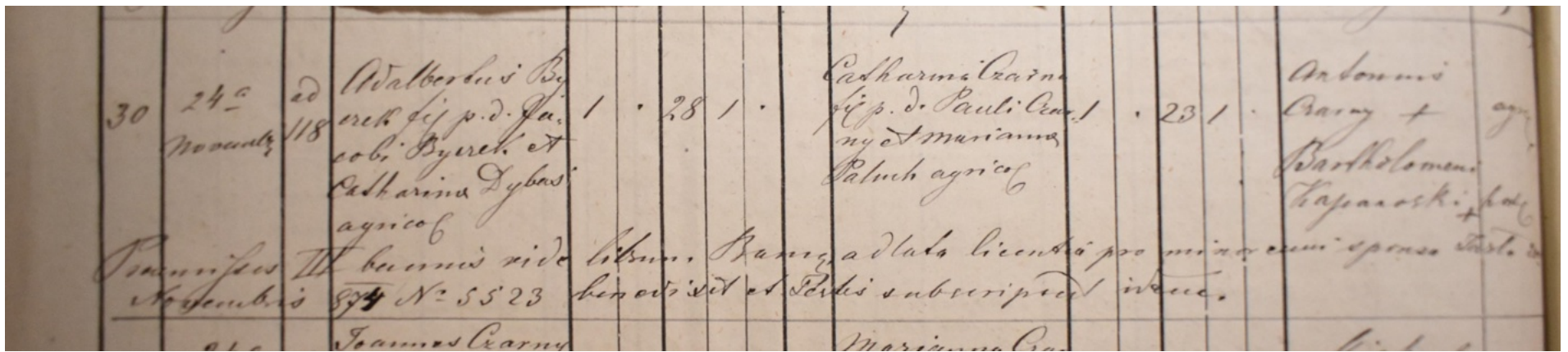

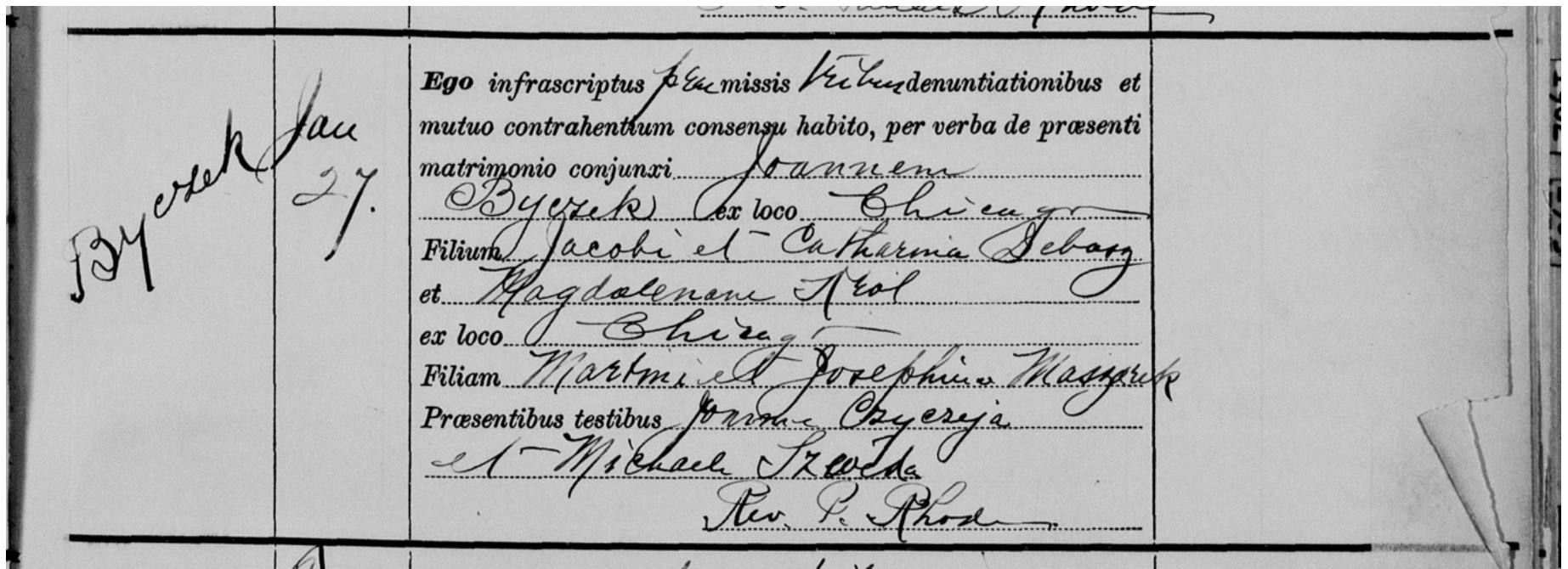

Notes

1. This marriage took place on the first day that weddings were held after the church opened
2. Magdalena's parents were listed as Martin Krol and Josephine Maszrek (surname is illegible). Her parents were actually Martin Krol and Sophia Maziarka. It is presumed that Josephine Maszrek was a phonetic error for Sophia Maziarka. Refer to a separate documentary about the Krol-Maziarka family for more information.

The first marriages in the parish took place on January 27, 1896, as Joseph Studzinski and Antoinette Brzeska, Adalbert Niegosz and Marianne Robak, John Byczek and Magdalena Krol exchanged vows of marriage in the presence of Father Paul Rhode, pastor. During the past one-hundred years, 3,868 weddings took place at the Church of SS. Peter and Paul.

The first Baptism at the Church of SS. Peter and Paul, then located at 36th and Justine, took place on December 29, 1895, as Francesca Kmiecik, born to Joseph and Agatha Kmiecik on December 27, 1895, was baptized by Father Paul Rhode in the presence of Godparents John Beczak and Harriet Gnatek. Little is known of what became of baby Francesca, however, her place in our parish history is well noted.

A booklet published for the 100 year anniversary of SS. Peter and Paul Church in Chicago makes special note about the first baptisms and marriages in the church  
The godparents for the first baptism are presumed to be brother and sister John Byczek and Hedwig (Byczek) Gnatek
