Paul (Paweł) Czarny and Marianna Paluch were married on 9/27/1830 at the Catholic Church located in Osobnica. Paul was 27 and Marianna was about 18 years old.

Paul was the son of Matthias (Maciej) Czarny and Marianna Wątroba from House #117 in Osobnica. He was baptized on 1/23/1803.

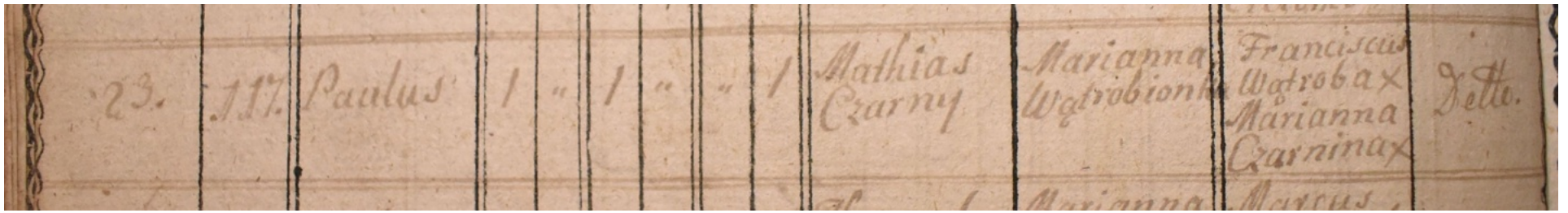
Marianna's place of birth is unknown. Her parents were Martin (Marcin) Paluch and Francisca (Franciszka) Stachacz. She was born about 1812. Marianna was living at House #89 in 1830.

Paul Czarny and Marianna Paluch had nine known children, all born at House #117 in Osobnica:

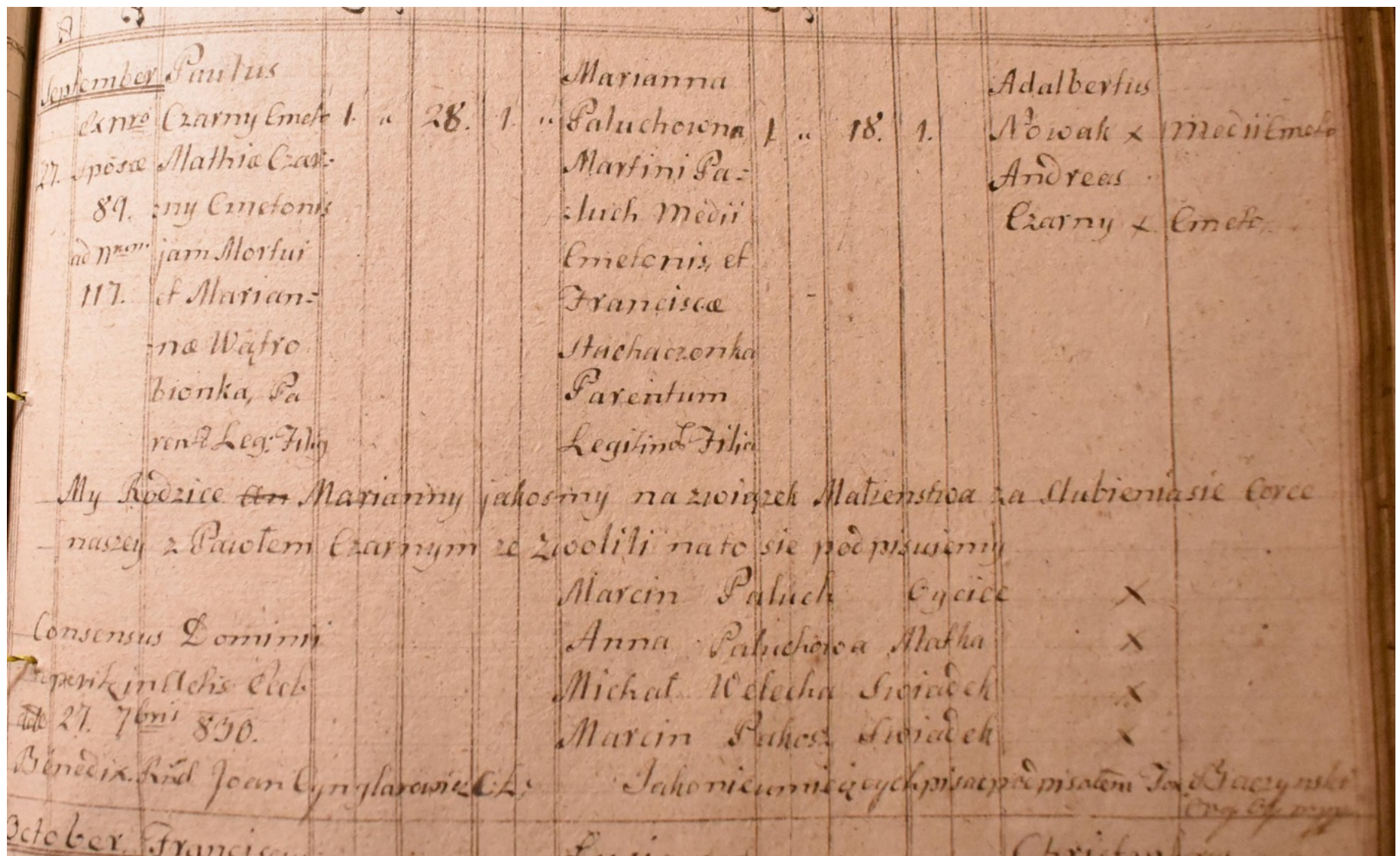

Their daughter Catherine Czarny married Adalbert (Wojciech) Byczek in 1874 at the church in Osobnica. They are Michael E. Byczek's 2x-great-grandparents. The Byczek family lived next door at #118 in Osobnica.

The death records for Paul Czarny and Marianna (Paluch) Czarny have not been verified.

The record indicates that Marianna Paluch's parents had to consent to the marriage due to her age. Her father was identified in the consent portion as Martin Paluch, but her mother was named Anna Paluch. There are two likely explanations. The first is that Anna was a mistake for Francisca, or Anna was her formal name (i.e. Anna Francisca). The second is that Francisca was deceased and Martin remarried. However, the record does not indicate her mother was dead or that the witness was a step-mother.

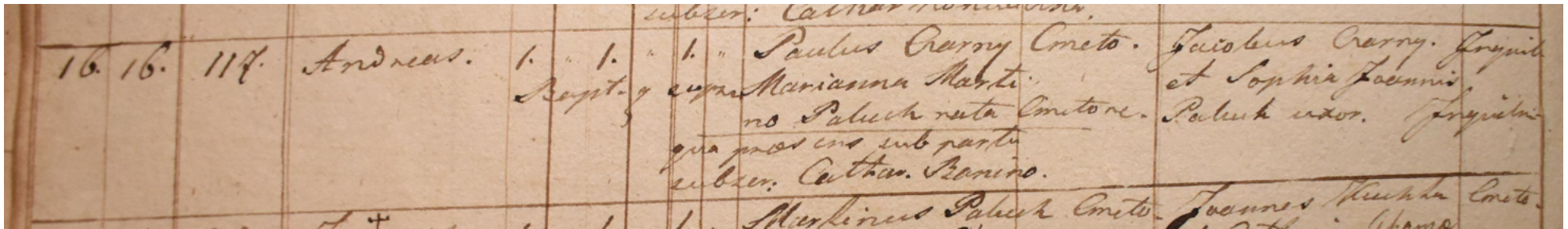

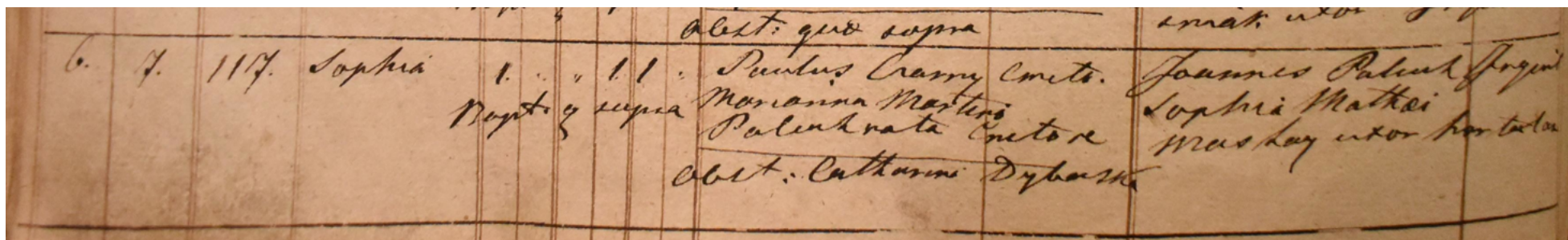

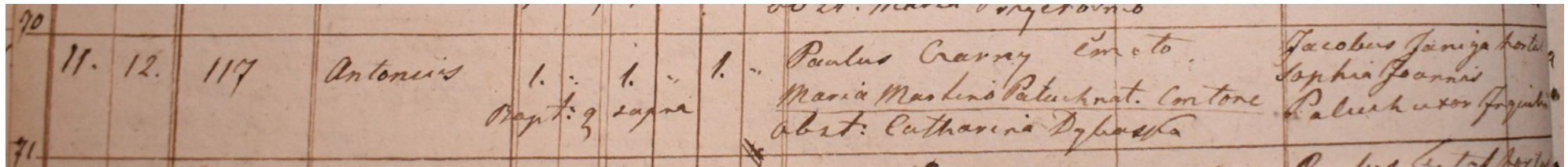

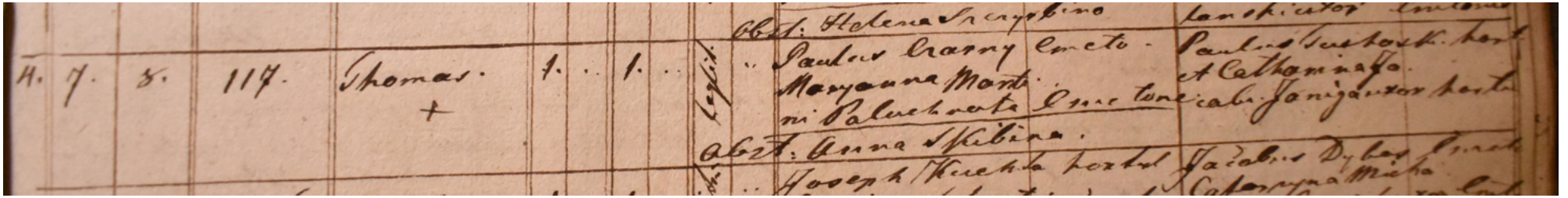


1843 Baptism of Anthony Czarny

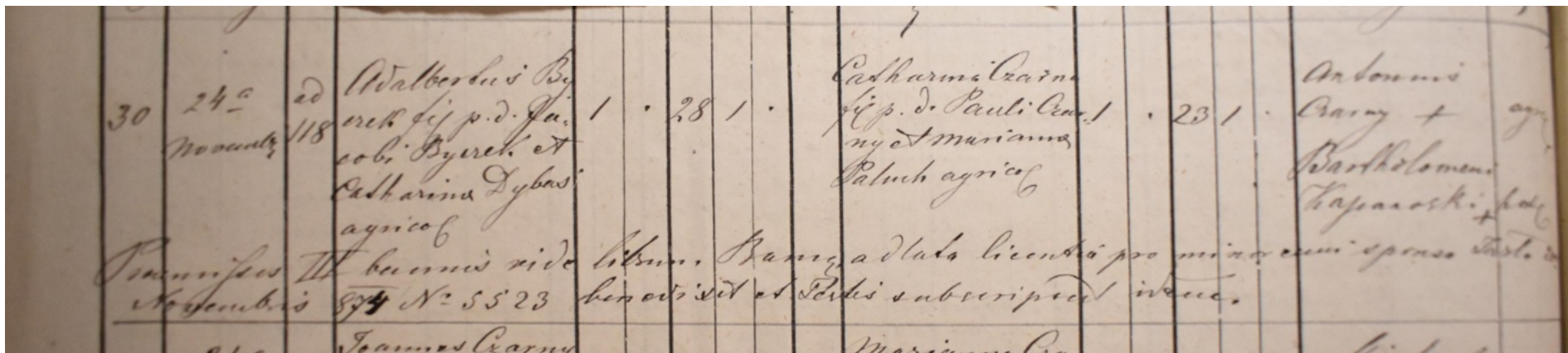

Byczek (grandfather) married Marie Flanagan in 1950 at St. Bridget's in Bridgeport. Their son Michael M. Byczek (father) married Betty A. Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children. Michael E. Byczek is the eldest and was born in Bridgeport.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County (Subcarpathian Voivodeship in southeastern Poland).
