

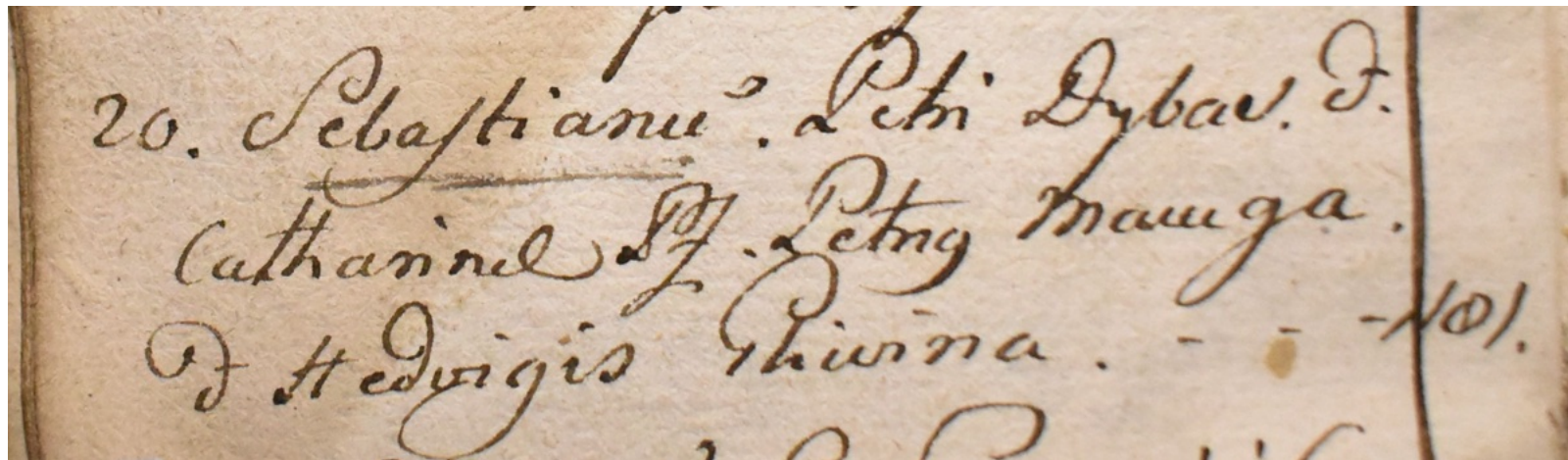
## Peter and Catherine Dybaś

Michael E. Byczek's 4x-great-grandparents were Sebastian Dybaś and Catherine (Katarzyna) Nowak who were married in 1805 at the Catholic Church located in Osobnica. On the balance of probabilities, it is more likely than not and highly plausible to be true that Sebastian was the son of Peter (Piotr) and Catherine (Katarzyna) Dybaś from House #181 in Osobnica. Sebastian is verified to have raised his family at House #181. A baptism was found for the appropriate year at House #181 that matches his age as listed in the marriage record. He was recorded as 23 years old with an estimated year of birth as 1782.

Digitized church records for Osobnica are not available for a complete year-by-year search of records pertaining to Peter and Catherine Dybaś. It is therefore not possible to determine Catherine's maiden name or their other children.

This is presumed to be the correct marriage record rather than a coincidence involving two couples with the same surnames, particularly because of House #187.

Bykowski in 1974 at St. Helen's on Augusta and Oakley in Chicago. They have two children. Michael E. Byczek is the eldest and was born in Bridgeport.

Osobnica is a village in the administrative district of Gmina Jasło, within Jasło County (Subcarpathian Voivodeship in southeastern Poland).
